

Rosegarth Surgery—Halifax



Background

The Practice were operating out of cramped, dated premises that had been extended twice in the past but had run out of room to expand further. Admin staff were working in rooms designated for meetings and training, and additional clinical space was required.

Ideally they were looking to relocate to new, purpose built premises but financial constraints made this impossible. A building next door to the surgery was purchased to convert into office space to create more clinical space in the surgery building itself. After discussions with Calderdale PCT, the Practice were granted funding for a refurbishment of the surgery and newly purchased building next-door.

The Brief

Design and carry out refurbishment of a 6 GP Training Practice serving 9000 patients and conversion of bungalow next door.

Surgery refurbishment to include new Reception and Waiting Area, 2 additional Treatment Rooms, Staff Kitchen and Admin Office. Bungalow to incorporate Training & Conference Room, Practice Manager and Community Nurse's Offices, Patient Records Storage and Staff Recreational Area. New Telephone and Patient Check-in systems to be installed and staff parking area to be resurfaced.
